## MATERIALS:

**BULKY (5) YARN - ABOUT 200 YARDS**

**6.5MM HOOK**

**FAUX FUR POM POM**

**YARN NEEDLE**

# PATTERN NOTES:

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**CHAIN: CH**

**STITCH: ST**

**DOUBLE CROCHET: DC**



## HAT SIZING:

**SMALL: 20" IN DIAMETER,  
10.5" IN LENGTH**

**MEDIUM: 22" IN DIAMETER  
12.5" IN LENGTH**

**LARGE: 24" IN DIAMETER  
14.5" IN LENGTH**

**LENGTH LISTED INCLUDES THE 2" CUFF**

**GAUGE (4X4): 13 DC X 5 ROWS**

**PATTERN SHOWS A MEDIUM SIZED HAT, WITH  
THE MEDIUM SIZE INSTRUCTIONS FIRST.  
ALTERNATE SIZES ARE SHOWN IN THE BRACKETS AS FOLLOWS:  
M (S,L)**

**FINAL HAT SIZE/NUMBER OF STITCHES NEEDED  
MAY VARY DUE TO YARN TYPE. WE USED  
PREMIER BASIX CHUNKY YARN. APPROXIMATELY  
200 YARDS (JUST UNDER 2 SKEINS) NEEDED FOR A MEDIUM HAT**

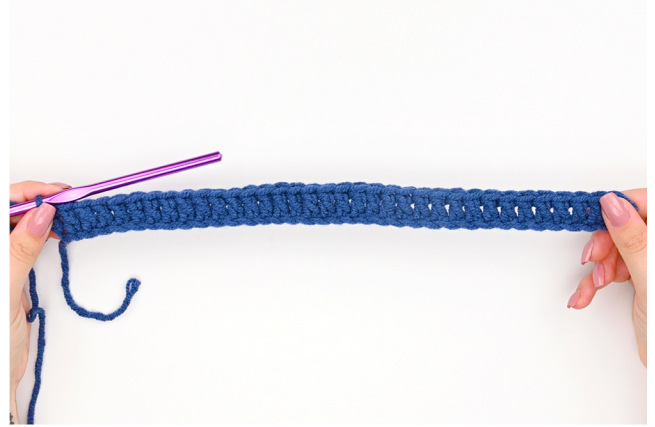
**ALWAYS DO A GAUGE TEST TO ENSURE PROPER SIZING**

**THE CHAIN 2 AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH ROW  
DOES NOT COUNT AS A STITCH**

**FOUNDATION: CH 37 (31, 43)**



**ROW 1: INSERT 1 DC INTO THE 3RD CH FROM THE HOOK, AND THEN EACH CH ACROSS**



**ROW 2: TURN YOUR WORK AND CH 2. WORK 1 DC INTO THE BACK LOOP ONLY OF EACH ST ACROSS**



**ROWS 3-27(24, 30): REPEAT ROW 2**



## **ASSEMBLY:**

**CUT AND TIE OFF YOUR YARN, LEAVING A 6" TAIL**



**FOLD YOUR RECTANGLE IN HALF AND SEW A RUNNING STITCH ACROSS THE LAST ROW OF STITCHES AND YOUR FOUNDATION CHAIN. THIS WILL FORM A TUBE (YOU MAY NEED TO ATTACH A SEPARATE PIECE OF YARN TO SEW THE SIDES TOGETHER)**



**USING THE SAME STRAND OF YARN,  
SEW A RUNNING STITCH ALL THE WAY  
AROUND THE TOP OF THE TUBE**



**PULL THE END OF THE YARN TIGHTLY,  
TO GATHER THE TUBE TOGETHER.  
TIE TO SECURE, AND WEAVE IN THE ENDS**



**ATTACH THE POM POM BY TYING  
THE TAIL LEFT FROM EARLIER  
THROUGH THE LITTLE ELASTIC, AND  
THROUGH THE TOP OF THE HAT, 2-3 TIMES**



**TIE IN YOUR ENDS AND FOLD THE BOTTOM  
OF THE HAT UP TO CREATE THE CUFF**
