

Crochet Scrunchie **PATTERN**

Materials:

Worsted weight or DK yarn

4.5 or 6.5mm hook (or 1 hook size up from recommended)

Hair elastic

Yarn needle

Scissors

Abbreviations:

Chain: ch

Slip stitch: ss

Single crochet: sc

Stitch: st

Pattern Notes:

- 1** This pattern covers 2 different sizes of scrunchies. One with worsted weight yarn and one with DK yarn. The variation will be shown in brackets.
- 2** This pattern works in continuous rounds, meaning there's no slip stitch or chain 1s at the beginning of each row.
- 3** The number of rows needed to complete this will depend on your elastic and the stretchiness of it. The scrunchie should be as long as the elastic is while it's stretched out.

Crochet Scrunchie



1

Starting with a slip knot, ch 16 (21).



2

Pull the foundation ch through the elastic.



3

Being careful not to twist your foundation, ss into the first ch, making a loop around the elastic.



4

Sc into each ch around.

5

When you get to the first sc, continue inserting scs into each st around, in continuous rounds.



6

Continue the scs until your work is the length of the elastic when stretched (and is as "scrunched" as you desire).



7

Cut and tie off your yarn leaving a 12" tail.



8

Use your needle and the long tail to sew the 2 ends of the scrunchie together.

Sew in your ends.
